Faithful Priorities: the Federal Budget as a Moral Document

places federal budget priorities in conversation with biblical principles of economic justice to empower Christians to explore the federal budget as a moral document.

The Cost of War provides tools to discern how Christians can live out the call to love God, neighbor, and enemy in the midst of a violent world so often at war.

A Nuclear Free World invites participants to grapple with the threat to God's creation posed by the creation, testing, and use of nuclear weapons.

Women and War: The Survival of Hope examines women's unique experiences of war in recent centuries and the nonviolent resistance of women of faith to war, including the historic contributions of Christian women.

War's Silent Casualty: The Eco-Footprint of War examines the tremendous ecological footprint of weapons production and war, highlighting the impact of human violence on all of God's creation.

Bringing Peace Home weaves together the threads of peace and justice found throughout the Bible and empowers participants to add their voices to the tradition of faithful action on behalf of peace.
